EATING DISORDER AWARENESS WEEK

27th February - 5th March

Approximately 1.25 million people in the UK have an eating disorder with numbers on the rise.

Although many eating disorders develop during adolescence, it is not unusual for people to develop them earlier or later in life. In fact, we are aware of cases of anorexia in children as young as 6 and some research reports cases developing in women in their 70s. When people are outside of the stereotypical age bracket, they are less likely to be appropriately diagnosed due to a lack of understanding and awareness.

- Do you ever make yourself Sick because you feel uncomfortably full?
- Do you worry you have lost Control over how much you eat?
- Have you recently lost more than **One** stone in a three month period?
- Do you believe yourself to be Fat when others say you are too thin?
- Would you say that Food dominates your life?
