Our practice is very pleased to continue offering our patients access to our 'enhanced access' hub through the Learnington North Primary Care Network. This hub offers a mixture of telephone and face-to-face GP appointments, as well as Nurse and Clinical Pharmacist appointments available for you to utilise in the evenings (18:30-21:00) and at the weekend (Saturday 9:30-16:30pm). If you need an appointment outside of normal hours, please ask a receptionist who would be happy to support you with booking an EA appointment which suits you and your availability.



Men's Health Week (12th -18th June)

This year's theme emphasises the impact of technology and social media on men's mental health. Mental health is an important aspect, in 2019, 76% of suicide in England and Wales were men, where suicide is the biggest killer of men under the age of 45. Out of hours information will be available on our phone system.


